

## FIELD RANKING ARCHERY RULES 2005

Rules for FITA Field Archery World Ranking. 2005. Please notice that 2005 is a test period (for the FAWR-administration) and the rules that will apply as from January 1st 2006 are different from the rules used during the test period. The major difference lies in the number of FAWR-tournaments. For the test period the number of tournaments is unlimited. For the actual ranking as per January 1st 2006, only tournaments with a FAWR-status will be taken into account. Rules:

1. All archers competing at an arrowhead tournament (we received the results from) will be listed in the ranking.
2. Only those archers that achieved at least 3 results will be ranked in the final ranking (per December 31st, 2005).
3. Archers with less than 3 results are listed in the ranking with a P (provisional).
4. Archers with less than 3 tournaments will be listed separately in the second section of the final ranking (without a ranking indication for 2006).
5. For an archer with more than 5 results the 5 best results are taken into account.
6. For archers with 3 - 5 results all results will be taken into account.
7. Results are processed based on the result lists provided by the organization.
8. If no special status such as: Did not Start (DNS); Did not finish (DNF) or Disqualified (DSQ); is indicated the result will be taken into account.
9. A double arrowhead round will count for one result.
10. Results from archers competing on only 1 of 2 days during a double arrowhead will not be taken into account.
11. Archers shooting under special (white posts etc...) conditions will not be taken into account. Classes with unknown indications (Students, Youngsters, Pupils, etc...) will not be taken into account.
12. For Longbow only those archers with a Longbow indication in the result list will be taken into account (other classes mostly are listed under Traditional or something like that).
13. Results for the FAWR-ranking are calculated results based on the weight assigned to a tournament.
14. The weight is calculated based on a reference group.
15. The calculated score will be displayed as being for a single day event (based on a 360 score).

### 2006/2007 (FAWR Test period).

1. All archers competing at an arrowhead tournament WITH FAWR-STATUS ASSIGNED will be listed in the ranking.
2. Only those archers that achieved the least 3 results will be ranked in the final ranking (per December 31st, 2006).
3. Only archers with at least 3 results are eligible for the FITA rewards. FITA rewards are available for all 32 categories provided at least 4 participants have achieved a final ranking.
4. Archers with less than 3 results are listed in the ranking with a P (provisional).
5. Archers with less than 3 tournaments will be listed separately in the second section of the final ranking (without a ranking indication for the next year).
6. For an archer with more than 5 results the 5 best results are taken into account.
7. For archers with 3 - 5 results all results will be taken into account.
8. Results are processed based on the result lists provided by the organization.
9. If no special status such as: Did not Start (DNS); Did not finish (DNF) or Disqualified (DSQ); is indicated the result will be taken into account.
10. A double arrowhead round will count for one result.
11. Results from archers competing on only 1 of 2 days during a double arrowhead will not be taken into account.
12. Besides arrowhead tournaments with FAWR-status also: World Championships Field; Continental Championships Field and World Games will be taken into account for ranking results.
13. The results achieved during a WCF will always have a weight of 1 (=100%).

14. The results of the other major field tournaments will be calculated results as are all other results.
15. Archers shooting under special (white posts etc...) conditions will not be taken into account.
16. Classes with unknown indications (Students, Youngsters, Pupils, etc...) will not be taken into account.
17. For Longbow only those archers with a Longbow indication in the result list will be taken into account (other classes mostly are listed under Traditional or something like that). The rules for Longbow (Yellow posts etc...) as set by FITA must be applied for the Longbow division.
18. Results for the FAWR-ranking are calculated results based on the weight assigned to a tournament.
19. The weight is calculated based on a reference group.
20. The calculated will be displayed as being for a single day event based on a 360 score.
