



COMPETITION RULES ALPE ADRIA FIELD CUP 2017

1. GENERAL

- Archery Federations of Austria, Croatia, Italy (represented by a Regional Team from Friuli Venezia-Giulia) and Slovenia established field archery Cup in the year 2010: **ALPE ADRIA FIELD CUP (AAFC)**.
- As from 2014 Hungarian Archery Association also officially takes part in the cup.
- Four international AAFC events within the AAFC will be organized each year, following WA Rules for Field Archery.
- 4 federations will organize AAFC event each year. One federation will according to rotation, refrain from organizing AAFC event in that year.
- For 2017 organizers will be Austrian, Croatian, Hungarian and Slovenian federation.
- The organizers will register the event in the WA-Calendar.
- Other WA members are allowed to take part in the events, but cannot be included in the AAFC results, and cannot obtain trophies or medals for the AAFC.

2. CLASSES

Junior, senior and master classes are joined according to gender.

- Women
- Men

3. DIVISIONS

- Barebow
- Recurve
- Compound

All characteristics of the bows are as described in the WA Rules for Field Archery.

4. CATEGORIES

- Barebow women
- Barebow men
- Recurve women
- Recurve men
- Compound women
- Compound men

5. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees will be laid down by the organizer.

6. INDIVIDUAL EVENT

The event will run over 1 or 2 days.

A competition format can consist of either:

- 1 day: 12 targets with unknown and 12 targets with known distances 12 + 12 or
- 2 days: each day 12 targets unknown and 12 targets known distances 2 x 12 + 12 or
- 2 days: per day separate 24 known and 24 unknown distances 24 + 24.

7. RANKING

- In each event competitors will gain ranking points according to following scheme:

rank	points
1	20
2	15
3	10
4	7
5	6
6	5
7	4
8	3
9	2
10	1
from 11 onwards	0

- In order to be included in the final classification of the AAFC, each athlete has to participate in at least three AAFC events.
- For the final classification only the best three ranks will be considered.
- At the final event shoot off will be organized in case the winner could not be resolved due to equal total rank points.

8. MEDALS AND TROPHIES

- For each Cup event:
The first 3 ranked athletes in each category will be awarded trophies or medals by the event organizer.
- Final Cup:
On the last tournament a trophy for the winner in each category of the AAFC will be awarded. Trophies will be provided by national federation according to the agreement. In the year 2017 trophies will be provided by the Slovenian Archery Federation.

9. RESULT PUBLICATION

- Each organizer of the AAFC event will prepare results for categories under article 4.
- Organizer of the first event will prepare classification table with rank points for each competitor.
- Classification table will then be forwarded from one organizer to the next one, so that the final ranking could be prepared.
- AAFC results must be published on the web site of the archery federation organizing the event not later than a week after the event and should be sent to the AAFC federations separately.
- Requests for corrections in the results of the AAFC event must be sent to the organizer within 10 days after the event.
- The federation hosting the final event is responsible for preparing and publishing the final AAFC results.

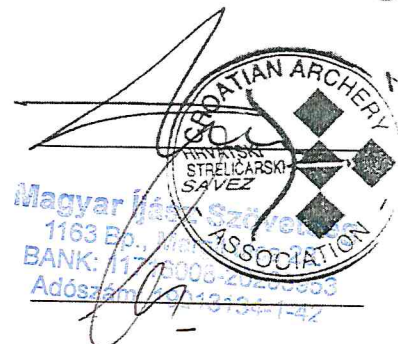
